ORDER

The Hon'ble Supreme Court appointed Justice (Rtd) Siri Jagan Committee to decide on the compensation to be awarded to the victims of Stray dog menace in kerala. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its judgment dated 16.07.2018 in CC No.944/17 in WP(C) No.599/15 read as 4th paper above ordered that it would be the obligation of the State to see that the compensation for stray dog victims as recommended by the Justice (Rtd) Siri Jagan Committee is strictly complied with and if it is not complied with the competent authorities of the State shall be liable for contempt of the Supreme Court and be adequately punished. In compliance to the Court order, after disbursing compensation along with interest to the claimants upto 17th reports, an affidavit has already been filed before the Supreme Court on 27.03.2019.

As per letter read as 7th paper above, the Advocate General, Ernakulam has furnished 19th and 20th report of the Justice (Rtd) Siri Jagan Committee recommended payment of compensation to the victims with interest @ 9% from the date of claim and the 21st report with certain recommendations.

Government have examined the matter in detail and sanction is awarded to the Secretaries of the local bodies concerned to pay the compensation awarded by the Commission to the following claimants in the 19th and 20th report of the Justice (Rtd) Siri Jagan Committee with interest @ 9% from the date of claim.

read as 3rd paper above has already enhanced the honorarium and direction has been given to the Director of Urban Affairs to comply the other recommendations of the Committee.

The compensation to the stray dog victims with interest @ 9% from the date of claim shall be disbursed by the Local Self Government Institutions concerned with immediate effect. The Director of Urban Affairs/Director of Panchayats shall ensure the timely disbursement of compensation by Local Self Government Institutions. A detailed compliance report in this regard shall be submitted to Government before 10.08.2019 and furnish Action Taken Report on the compliance of the Government Order read as 3rd paper above.
